POOL HOURS: MONDAY-SATURDAY 11:00 – 8:00/SUNDAYS 12:00 – 8:00 (WEATHER PERMITTING)

POOL RULES

1. Swimming pool opens Memorial Day weekend through Labor Day. The pool will open at 11:00 a.m. (12:00 on Sunday) if the temperature is 65 degrees or above (according to the Weather Channel) at 10:30 a.m. If not it will be checked again at 12:00 p.m. and if not it will be checked again at 3:30 p.m. If the temperature hasn't reached 65 degrees by 3:30 p.m. the pool will remain closed for the day.
2. Privileges to members and guests only. Members are responsible for guest conduct. **GUESTS & MEMBERS MUST SIGN IN.** Members may bring guests any day at a cost of \$3 per guest per day.
3. No running or pushing in the pool area.
4. Water games permitted with permission from lifeguard on duty.
5. One diver on the board at a time. Diving must be straight out from the board.
6. No non-swimmers allowed in pool area unless with a parent or responsible adult. Babysitters must be 12 years of age or older and must register with the lifeguards.
7. No glass containers or food allowed in the immediate pool area.
8. Lifeguards have full authority over pool activities, including admission, warnings and expulsions.
9. Children not potty trained must wear "potty proof" swimwear. Diaper changing must be done in the Bath House.

Register at the pool house anytime in June. Registration closes on Wednesday, June 23. It is important that you sign up **BEFORE** the 1st day of class. If we don't have enough students enrolled, that level **will not** be taught. Likewise, if there is a need we will offer 2 sessions of the same level. Cost is \$25 per child, payable at registration or billed to your club account.

We will give a skill test the 1st day of class and move children as needed. There are handout sheets at the pool house listing what skills your child must have in order to enroll in each level. Please note that the Red Cross has revised the levels & different skills are now taught at levels 3 & 4 in particular. There are now Pre-school levels 1-3. There is also a file in the pool house that should show what level your child took in the past at this pool and if he/she passed. This would be for those students who took lessons under Paula Templemeyer. If you have any questions please call Paula at 955-5563.

Class size: minimum 5 maximum 12

Pre-school Level 2	11:00 –11:25	Must be already able to put face in/go underwater. Recommended age 4 yrs old.
Level 2A	10:30-10:55	Fundamental Aquatic Skills-already able to float front & back, work on basics of front crawl & treading water.
Level 2B	9:30-9:55	If needed (Level 2A must be filled)
Level 3A	10:00-10:25	Stroke development-build on Level 2 skills in deeper water. Learn rotary breathing, elem. Backstroke, more kicks.
Level 3B	11:00-11:25	If needed (Level 3A must be filled)
Level 4	10:30-10:55	Stroke Improvement-Learn back crawl, breaststroke, butterfly & sidestroke, learn turns.
Level 5	10:00-10:25	Stroke refinement- work on further coordination & flip turns.
Level 6	9:30-9:55	Swimming & skill proficiency-2 options/ Fitness Swimming or Personal Water Safety-swimming laps up to 500 yards.

If necessary some upper Levels might be combined. Paula Templemeyer, WSI, will be managing these lessons. Private lessons can be arranged with either Paula or the guards.

NET SCORE EACH HOLE

BOGEY=1 POINT
PAR=2 POINTS
BIRDIE=3 POINTS
EAGLE=4 POINTS
DOUBLE EAGLE=5 POINTS

MAXIMUM HANDICAP WILL BE SET @ 18 FOR 9 HOLE SCORING. PLAYERS WITH MAXIMUM HANDICAP OF 12 WILL START WITH A POINTS QUOTA OF 0. EXAMPLE: PLAYER WITH 9 HOLE HANDICAP OF 12 WILL NEED TO MAKE A POINTS QUOTA OF 6 POINTS (SCORE 2 NET PARS & 2 NET BOGEYS). ANY ADDITIONAL SCORING WILL BE ADDED TO THE PLAYERS SCORE FOR THE ROUND. TEAM SCORING WILL BE BASED ON THE ACCUMULATED POINTS FOR THE 4 PERSON TEAM DESIGNATED FOR THAT WEEKS MATCH. EXAMPLE: PLAYER A= +6 POINTS.....PLAYER B= +2 POINTS, PLAYER C= -2 POINTS.....PLAYER D= +4 POINTS. TOTAL FOR TEAM= +10 POINTS. MOST POINTS WIN.
